**STUBAI GLACIER**  
Way up high above 3000 m – that is winter on Stubai Glacier, with snow guaranteed from October until May. Austria's biggest glacier ski area is just a 45-minute drive from Innsbruck. 26 state-of-the-art cable car and lift facilities connect 35 easy to challenging ski runs. Also inspiring is the versatile BIG Family offer, Snowpark Stubai Zoo and the Freeride Powder Department. An excursion to the spectacular summit platform TOP OF TYROL 3210 m, which provides 360° panoramic views, is a unique experience.



**KÜHTAI**  
Way up high in Kühtai – pure, snow-assured skiing fun in Austria's highest winter sports location, Ski Resort Innsbruck at 2020 metres. Ski right to the hotel doorstep, or car park. A mere 30 minutes from Innsbruck, 47 kilometres of pistes and 12 lift facilities await, meeting everyone's needs. It is not just families that adore the wide slopes, freeskiers and snowboarders have their own home-base in KPARK Kühtai with its FreeStyle Area and KidsPark, which guarantees action for children and Funpark newbies.



**INNSBRUCKER NORDKETTENBAHNEN**  
Just a short walk from the historic Old Town area is the contemporary cable car station designed by Zaha Hadid, from where you can head into the Nordkette ski area. From the 'Jewel of the Alps', you get to enjoy a 360° view to Innsbruck, Austria's biggest nature park – the Karwendel - and the selection of options available in Nordkette: 6 pistes, numerous freeride variants, the in-city snow park, 'Nordkette Skylinepark,' which is one of a kind in the world, and a supervised children's area. The excursion high point is, quite literally just that - TOP OF INNSBRUCK on the Hafelekar.



**PATSCHERKOFEL**  
1674 metres above the town, Innsbruck's local mountain reveals its loveliest aspects in the winter. The Patscherkofel, just a ten minute drive from Innsbruck, is a winner with the Patscherkofelbahn, a 10-seater monicable gondola lift, along with family-friendly and challenging pistes, the legendary Olympia ski run, 15,000 m<sup>2</sup> Kofele's Kinderland, signposted ski tours and snowshoe hikes, winter hiking paths and the popular snow park.

**IMPERIAL PALACE INNSBRUCK**  
The Imperial Palace Innsbruck features impressive rooms, including the imperial apartments and the historic state rooms and the giant hall, the most splendid festival hall in the Alps.



**CITY TOWER**  
133 steps take you up to the viewing platform at Innsbruck's city tower, which was built in the 15th century. It provides the best views to the city and the surrounding mountains.

**'MAXIMILIAN I.' LONG-TERM EXHIBITION**  
Via multi-media elements and digital mediation concepts, this long-term exhibition provides exciting insights into the life and times of Emperor Maximilian I.



**ALPENZOO INNSBRUCK – TIROL**  
For animal lovers, Europe's highest themed zoo, which has some 2000 alpine animals, is a unique experience above Innsbruck's rooftops.

**CITY ARCHIVE INNSBRUCK**  
Many different approaches to the city's history open up here. An active interchange between the city archive and the city museum provides exciting exhibitions.



**GOLDEN ROOF MUSEUM**  
Here the story of this building and its creator, Emperor Maximilian I., are told. Interactive elements and multimedia technologies take you on a journey into late medieval times.

**ZEUGHAUS MUSEUM**  
The Zeughaus provides insights into Tyrol's past, while interactive stations and personal accounts build bridges to the present. The museum invites you to challenge history.



**SWAROVSKI CRYSTAL WORLDS**  
Just 20 kilometres east of Innsbruck you are whisked away into a world filled with imagination and unique features. Be enchanted in the Chambers of Wonder and the large garden made of crystal in all its guises.



**AUDIOVERSUM SCIENCE CENTRE**  
The interactive experience world in Audioversum provides a versatile blend of entertainment and education. In the main exhibition 'Listening Experience', numerous interactive stations tempt you to get involved, be amazed and grasp various concepts.

**MUSEUM OF TYROLEAN REGIONAL HERITAGE**  
The museum provides an insight into agricultural life as it used to be. Walk into original farmhouse snugs, marvel at colourful traditional costumes, artisan crafts, Christmas cribs and many other heritage-oriented exhibits.

**TYROL PANORAMA AND KAISERJÄGER MUSEUM**  
Here, the 1000 square metre giant panorama painting is the main attraction. The theme is the famous battle on the Bergisel in 1809. The adjoining Kaiserjägermuseum documents Tyrol's military history.



**BELL MUSEUM & BELL FOUNDRY GRASSMAYR**  
The bell foundry which is over 400 years old, recounts the history, genesis and technique of bell casting. The sound room invites you to enjoy an acoustic bell experience.



**BERGISEL STADIUM & SKI JUMP**  
The jump, re-designed in 2001 by Zaha Hadid, is not just a visitor magnet during the Four Hills Tournament. The 50 metre tower, complete with panorama restaurant, has become a contemporary landmark.

**ANATOMICAL MUSEUM**  
The anatomical collection at the University of Innsbruck presents skeletons, skulls and models of people. Wet and dry preserved specimens are there to look at, including glasses containing preserved organs.

**TYROLEAN MUSEUM OF RAILWAYS**  
The development of local train routes in Tyrol, South Tyrol and Trentino are on display here. Some 25 historically valuable vehicles are presented.

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**AMBRAS CASTLE INNSBRUCK**  
This splendid Renaissance castle is regarded as being the world's first museum. It accommodates Archduke Ferdinand II's Chamber of Art and Curiosities and the unique Spanish Hall, among other features.



**LUMAGICA INNSBRUCK**  
The historic Imperial Gardens are transformed into a fantastic, magical world with the magical lights park LUMAGICA Innsbruck.

**TAXISPALAIS ART MUSEUM TYROL**  
TAXISPALAIS displays exciting, international contemporary art.

**DIE BÖRSE BIKE HIRE (3 HOURS)**  
With the City Services provided in the SKI plus CITY pass, use of a city bike or a children's bike is free for 3 hours – subject to availability. Hire is not available during bad weather, or when roads are snow-covered.



**BURG HASEGG / HALL MINT MUSEUM**  
The museum in the medieval castle displays silver coins, machinery and tools for making coins. Make your own memory by minting a coin just for you!



**COURT CHURCH**  
In the middle of the Court Church you can see an impressive monument to Emperor Maximilian I. 28 striking bronze statues, representing illustrious VIPs from medieval times, keep watch over the cenotaph.

**CITY WALKING TOUR WITH CITY GUIDES**  
During a walking tour of the city you get to explore Innsbruck Old Town and can learn about its history in an entertaining and exciting manner. 1-hour Welcome Tour in German from 11:00 to 12:00 NOV to APR: MON, WED, FRI, SAT (max. 35 people, advance registration) Meeting point: Tourist Information Innsbruck, Burggraben 3, 6020 Innsbruck (for 10 people and over, other languages available upon advance registration).

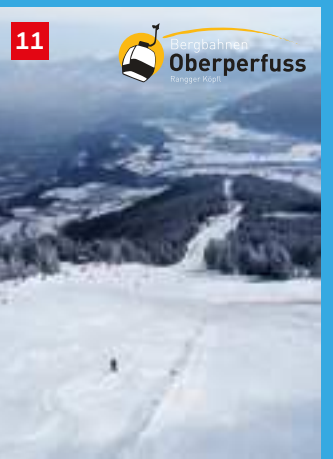
**AXAMER LIZUM**  
With over 40 kilometres of pistes and 9 lift facilities, Axamer Lizum is the biggest ski area at the gateway to Innsbruck. Pistes of varying difficulty levels guarantee snow-filled adventures for all the family. The new 10-seater gondolas Hoadl 1 and 2 take you from the car park to Panoramarestaurant Hoadl-Haus at 2340 m, in just a few minutes. Freestylers enjoy cool obstacles in the Golden Roof Snowpark, while freeriders will find countless powder runs around the Kalkkögel. The high Alpine location provides snow-assuredness from the end of November until the middle of April.



**HOCHOETZ**  
41 kilometres of pistes, state-of-the-art cable cars, snow-assuredness right through to spring, activity programme and supervision for children, two viewing points and superb events – the selection available makes Hochoetz ski region a genuine winter paradise for all the family. With 71 days of sunshine each season, Hochoetz is one of the 10 sunniest ski areas in Austria, scoring points with its manageability and inspiring with variety-packed ski runs and special features including WIDI's MOVIE SHUTTLE, WIDI's Fun Park and the Wild Animal course.



**SERLESBAHNEN**  
In the Serlesbahnen area in Mieders, families, beginners and those getting back into the swing of things will find just what they are looking for: easy, wide pistes which are great for learning to ski on and on which you enjoy making expansive turns after a long break from skiing. Kinderland with its magic carpet and button lift is right at the valley station. Those of you looking for mountain adventures away from the piste will find exactly that here – as well as tobogganing and snowshoe hiking, numerous winter hiking paths provide unique views to the surrounding mountains.



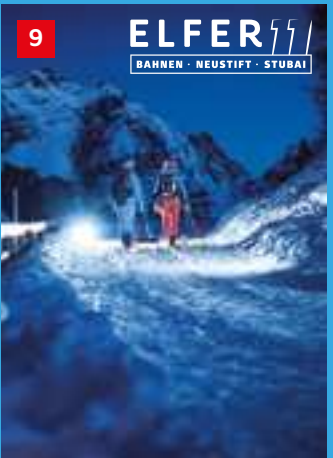
**OBERPERFUSS – RANGGER KÖPFL**  
Very close to Tyrol's state capital is the Rangger Köpfl, which is perfectly suited to a day of winter sports for all the family. The very easy blue to red pistes, combined with state-of-the-art ascent aids set every skier's heart aflutter. The Rangger Köpfl also has a fantastic toboggan run providing over 10 km of fun tobogganing (of which 8 km are floodlit), and idyllic winter hiking trails to boot!



**SCHLICK 2000 SKI CENTRE**  
Schlick 2000 – just 15 minutes from Innsbruck – is known for being a family ski area which, with 9 traditional Alpine lodges & inns, emphasises Tyrolean hospitality and fantastic quality pistes. In BIG Ron's Kinderland, children learn how to ski in a fun way, while in the play & warm-up snug, supervision is provided for infants from the age of one onwards. Meanwhile, adrenaline junkies head for Stubai Park Schlick 2000. The speed section and altitude profile measurement by Skiline ignite more ambition. Highlight: the new 10-seater Galtbergbahn and the 3 new sunny pistes!



**MUTTERERALM CABLE CARS**  
Over 15 kilometres of pistes provide pure white symbiosis, just 10 minutes from Innsbruck city centre! Whether you are a beginner, are getting back into the swing of things again, or a proficient skier – everyone is well catered for here. The ski runs around the mountain station provide ideal conditions, while the pistes to Mutters and Götzens are a real challenge. Pure adrenaline awaits in the Snow Park. Two toboggan runs round out the action-packed winter offer available on the Muttereralm.



**ELFERBAHNEN**  
20 minutes from Innsbruck is the valley station for Elferbahnen. The Elferbahnen offers proficient skiers and snowboarders dreamy trails filled with natural snow and guaranteed adrenaline. Activity-oriented holiday-makers can explore the winter hiking trails and the biggest walk-in sun dial in the Alps, which are very well-prepared and floodlit for tobogganning adventures at night.



**GLUNGEZERBAHN**  
The extensive 10-seater gondola takes winter sports enthusiasts directly to the Halsarter intermediate station in just six and a half minutes. From there, take the 'Tulfein Express' – a state-of-the-art combi cable-car – up to the Tulfein mountain station. Gondola or chair lift sports fans are able to choose from either ascent type. The Panoramarodelbahn from the mountain station is a special highlight for tobogganing fans. During a leisurely stop-off or while on a decent on the pistes, the surrounding impressive mountains are always in sight!
