

Dear trainers and training managers!

We make every effort to ensure that the training sessions run smoothly and efficiently for you and your teams.

We therefore ask you to observe the following points:

1. After your written or telephone inquiry (to ensure that your inquiry is processed quickly, we ask you to send all correspondence by email) to the Eisgrat Information Center, the following documents will be sent to you:

- Information letter
- agreement
- registration form
- Short list

2. Upon receipt of these documents, please return the signed agreement and the registration form to the Eisgrat information office as a PDF, so that a reservation can be noted on the piste map.

3. TRAINERMEETING:

Every trainer is obliged to attend the trainer meeting every day between 11 AM + 1 PM!

➤ **October 07 to December 15, 2024 -> Information, Eisgrat mountain station**

At this meeting, the registered slopes are then permanently allocated.

If there is a registration but the trainer is not present at the session, the reservation is invalid and will be deleted from the piste plan!

On the 1st day of training, the trainer must check the screens at the 3S Eisgratbahn and Gamsgartenbahn valley stations to find out which piste has been allocated to him/her. On the following days, the daily team meeting serves as a source of information about the allocation of the respective sections! Changes after the coaches' meeting will not be accepted without exception!

4 Please note that registrations and reservations must be adapted to the weather, snow and slope conditions. The number of slopes made available may change at any time due to current events.

5 We reserve the right to merge groups in the event of high utilization of our training areas. The groups merged at the team meeting must also comply with this. If this is not the case, both groups will be removed from the schedule.

6. Out of fairness to other training groups, it is necessary that a reservation on your part is cancelled as soon as possible if you are unable to keep the appointment for organizational reasons. If we do not receive any notification, your requests for slope reservations will no longer be processed in the future.

7. The use of Ski Doos and snow colorants is strictly prohibited! The carrying of flammable substances (gasoline,...) in cable car buildings and cable car facilities is strictly prohibited according to the Cable Car Act!

8. Poles are only used to transport material to the mountain stations of the Gamsgarten and Eisgratbahn lifts. No Snow groomer will be provided for onward transportation. The cable car company accepts no liability for the loss of gate poles!

9. The instructions of the staff must be followed at all times!

10. Pushing forward at the queuing rows is prohibited! For safety reasons, at least one supervisor must remain with the team members in the queuing rows, especially at the valley stations, to ensure safety and order. Reckless behavior will result in the exclusion of the entire team without replacement. In this context, priority is given to the safety and orderliness of the cable car facilities.

11. It is also strictly forbidden to get on the drag lifts on the course or to get off the drag lifts prematurely on the course!

12. The coaches are responsible for his/her section of the lane during the training. The Stubaier Gletscherbahn assumes no liability for damages of any kind.

13. Training sessions can be held from 8:00 to 12:00 and 13:00 to 15:00. A reserved piste section for the morning does not automatically mean that it is also available in the afternoon.

14. The coach must be on site on the reserved lane section no later than 45 minutes after the start of operations, otherwise it will be allocated to other training groups. In the event of delays, the trainer must call the Eisgrat information desk (0043 5226 8141 345).

16. Backpacks etc. are only to be deposited in the designated places in the starting areas of the training runs. Please use the free rucksack depot in the self-catering room Eisgrat --- because of escape routes in case of emergencies, no depositing in the entrance area of the buildings is permitted!

18. The participants of the groups can ski on all slopes, but must adhere to the FIS rules for other winter sports enthusiasts!

19. Free storage facilities for gate poles are available at the Eisgrat and Rotadl Lift mountain stations (the cable car company accepts no liability for the items deposited).

20. Willful damage (gondola disks, bubbles,...) will be reported to the police. The trainer responsible must pay for the damage caused.

21 From the lower half of training slope 9 is training slope 9K. You may only enter this runway from the top, from the start area (signage). Crossing the lines represents a major safety risk and must therefore be avoided!

22 The individual lines on training slope 9 are numbered. The lines are allocated at the coaches' meeting and must be adhered to.

23 Training can only take place if the snow and slope conditions are suitable. The Stubaier Gletscherbahn does not give a binding commitment for the reserved training slopes if atmospheric reasons (no/too little snow, icy slopes...) do not allow training operations or if the training offer is generally only available to a limited extent.
