

## Dear coaches!

We will do our utmost to ensure the smooth and efficient running of the training sessions for you and your teams.

You are therefore requested to observe the following points:

1. Upon receipt of your inquiry in writing or by phone to the Eisgrat information centre we will send you the following documents:

- informative memo
- agreement form
- registration form

2. Upon receipt of these documents you are kindly requested to return the agreement and the registration form to the Eisgrat information centre by no later than 31st July so that we can make the necessary reservation on the piste schedule.

### **3. TRAINER MEETING:**

**Every trainer must participate in the Trainer Meeting daily at 12:30!**

➤ **From 5 October to 1 December 2019** → **Seminar Room Eisgrat**

Registered slopes will then be definitively allocated to the teams.

Even though a current reservations exist without the coaches appearance at the meeting the registration will be cancelled without exception!

In other to find out which slope has been allocated to the teams each coach is requested to get in contact with the Information center at the Eisgrat terminal or to take a look at the board with the pist schedule at the entrance of the Gamsgarten cable car on the first day of training.

On subsequent days the daily team meeting shall act as your source of information on the allocation of each piste section.

Mind that amendments will NOT be accepted in any case after the team meeting has been held.

4. Note that the amount of available slopes for training have to be adjusted to the prevailling weather and to snow and piste conditions.

Mind that teams which have to share one slope have to accept this order otherwise both reservations will be cancelled.

5. In the event that our training areas are extremely busy we reserve the right to merge groups.

6. Out of fairness to other training groups you are required to cancel a reservation as soon as possible if you are unable to keep to the appointed time for organisational reasons. In the event that we do not receive any notification from you in such cases we will no longer take any further requests from you into consideration.

7. Use of skidoos is strictly prohibited! The colouring of the piste is forbidden. Also the transport of fuel in the stations and surroundings of the buildings is strictly prohibited.

8. Gate posts shall only be transported as equipment to the mountain terminals of the Gamsgartenbahn, Schaufeljochbahn and Eisgratbahn. Piste maintenance machines shall not be provided for the purposes of further transport. Stubaier Gletscherbahn shall not be held liable for any lost gate posts! Gate posts which are left behind after training next to the edge of the slopes will be collected by a member of staff who will charge a deposit of € 25,00.

Information about storage are given at the Information center at the Eisgrat terminal.

9. Always follow the instructions of service staff to the full.

10. Pushing forward to the front of lines is prohibited!

11. Getting on to the ski tow midway and getting off the ski tow along the way before reaching the end is strictly prohibited

12. The trainer and/or head trainer is responsible for his/her section of the piste during the training session. Stubaier Gletscherbahn shall not be held liable for any damage.

13. Training sessions can be held 8am to 12noon and from 1pm to 3pm. A piste section that has been reserved for the morning does not necessarily mean that it will also be available in the afternoon.

14. The trainer must be present at the reserved slope section no later than 45 minutes after the start of operations or be assigned to other training groups. Trainers are to report tardiness by calling the Info Eisgrat number at 0043 5226 8141 345.

16. All kinds of luggage must not be stored at the start or nearby of a race course (like Windach) and also not at the entrance of the Eisgrat building. Use the storage at the self-catering room Eisgrat.
17. Each team will be assigned a current number in our database. To speed up the processing time for you, please ask for your assigned number at Eisgrat information centre. You will need it each time you make a reservation.
18. The FIS rules must be observed during “warm up” and “free ski” for ski racers on the public slopes. Show consideration for all skiers!

19. At the entrance of the Schaufeljoch cable car storage possibilities are offered free of charge. Note that there is no liability for stored luggage! Poles which are stored at the exit of the Eisgrat cable car will be removed immediately!
20. Intentional damage (to gondola windows, bubbles, etc.) will be prosecuted. Trainers are liable for damage caused under their supervision.
21. We will be offering a new slope section on Daunferner beginning this autumn. The new **9K** training slope is located on the lower half of training slope 9, between the giant slalom and Super-G. Skiers may only warm up on this slope in the top section, beginning in the starting area, between the giant slalom and Super-G (marked by signs). Crossing the lines poses a major safety risk and should therefore not be done!
22. On the lower part of slope nr. 9 between the giant slalom- and SuperG lane there is lane 9K which is new. Groups are only allowed to start from above between giant slalom and SuperG where a signpost will be put up. For safety reasons it is strictly prohibited to cross the lanes before the signpost.
23. The lines on slope nr. 9 and slope nr. 7 are numbered. The lines will be allocated to the teams at the daily coaches meeting and must be kept to.
24. Training sessions can only be held if snow and slope conditions are appropriate to do so. The Stubai Glacier Cableway cannot commit to honouring training slope bookings if atmospheric conditions do not permit training (no/little snow, icy slopes...), or if there is only a limited training programme on offer.
