agreement

is concluded:

1. The validity period of this agreement is limited to the following period:

Start of skiing operations in autumn 2021 to the end of the skiing operations in spring 2022

The organiser is permitted to organise a sporting competition in the form of a time or training run (hereinafter referred to as “event”) during the above-mentioned period after prior registration at the Eisgrat information office.

2. The organiser expects approx. _____ active and approx. _____ passive participants for the event.
3. For the realisation of the event mentioned above and for the duration of the same, the party entitled to dispose of the ski area provides a designated piste/piste section/route to the organiser. If the designated routes are fully booked, no training/race route can be allocated. Allocation and administration takes place exclusively through the Eisgrat information office.

A training can only be carried out in the case of appropriate snow and piste conditions. The Stubaier Gletscherbahn do not make a binding commitment for the reserved training pistes, if atmospheric reasons (no/too little snow, icy pistes...) do not allow for trainings to take place or if the training offers is generally only available to a limited extent.

The party to dispose of the terrain that is considered for the event mentioned above, informs the organiser at the same time that the hosting of winter/ski sports events is generally not covered by the designation of the area for public winter sports / skiing and therefore winter sports events may only be held on pistes / piste sections, where no public winter sports / skiing takes place at the same time. The spatial limitation of the area provided for the event (the race / training) is determined on site by the responsible representative of the lift company (managing director, operations manager, piste

manager etc.).The public winter sports / skiing guests will be made aware of the closing of the piste area concerned by the party entitled to dispose of the ski area(lift company).

4. The organiser of the time or training run is solely responsible for the process, organisation and security of the event and the event site concerned. In particular, the organiser has the following obligations:
 - 4.1. The event is exclusively to be held on the allocated pistes or piste sections as well as during the limited period mentioned above.
 - 4.2. The organiser is responsible for the appropriate protection of the race/training route against spectators, uninvolved people and all other winter athletes / skiers.
 - 4.3. In any case, the event site must be secured in such a way that persons not participating are not endangered by the dangers – whatever kind - arising from the event.
 - 4.4. The event area, including the room intended for spectators, must be clearly separated from the parts of the piste intended for public skiing and marked in a way that both active and passive event participants and piste users not participating in the event can clearly see how far the event area extends of which space is intended for this.
 - 4.5. The organiser must take all necessary security measures that are customary for events of the planned type and that are necessary to ensure the physical safety of all active and passive participants as well as the third parties and those not participating in the event.
 - 4.6. After the end of the race / training, the organiser has to remove all slalom gates, barriers and other obstacle s (e.g. broken slalom gates, timing cables etc.) so that the piste / route can be used safely again by winter sports athletes / piste users.
 - 4.7. The coach or training manager is responsible for his/her piste section during the training. The Stubai Gletscherbahn assume no liability for damage of any kind.
 - 4.8. It is the responsibility of every coach who leads a line to ensure that there is sufficient distance between the runners starting from the left and right.
5. With the signature the organiser confirms
 - 5.1. to have the necessary expertise for fulfilling the obligations above.
 - 5.2. to meet the obligations mentioned above.
 - 5.3. to indemnify the party to dispose of the ski area (lift company) from all claims arising from holding the event above.
 - 5.4. to have received, read and understood the information letter for coaches of the Stubai Gletscherbahnen.
 - 5.5. to have read and understood the FIS rules (<http://www.fis-ski.com/data/document/10-fis-rules-for-conduct.pdf>).
6. Compensation for any costs incurred by the party entitled to dispose of (lift company) such as provision of materials, preparation and the like, a separate agreement will be concluded if applicable.
7. The organiser expressly declares that he/she has all the necessary permits and powers to carry out the event.
8. Data privacy statement: The person responsible on behalf of the club agrees that the given club and personal data are used for purpose-related information e-mails and for the training info TV at the base stations.
9. **ATTENTION: On the following weekends no afternoon training is possible on training piste 7 + 7R. The slaloms are to be cleared by 12:00 p.m. of the respective day without exception and the runs must be smoothed by skidding! (30.10 + 31.10.2021, 6.11+7.11.2021, 13.11+14.11.2021, 20.11+23.11.2021, 27.11+28.11.2021)**

DATA PROTECTION DECLARATION

For the purposes of contract performance and taking steps prior to entering into a contract, the personal data (addresses, telephone numbers, email addresses) of partners from contracts are automatically

If a contractual partner does not want their data to be processed by Wintersport Tirol AG & Co, Stubaier Bergbahnen KG any more, they can notify us of this in writing immediately. We, Wintersport Tirol AG & Co, Stubaier Bergbahnen KG, will erase all data immediately and informed the data subject or contractual partner of this. Should there be compelling legal grounds preventing erasure, the data subject or contractual partner will be informed of these immediately.
